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Dear Parents/Carers,

This year, each class will have sessions in our outdoor learning area. This area includes a range of open-ended opportunities for children to build their resilience, develop their social and communication skills as well as be creative within nature.

In order to ensure the sessions run smoothly and safely, children should come to school on the day of their session wearing a long-sleeved top/jumper and long trousers. They should also have waterproofs as sessions will still take place in moderate wet weather (not if there is torrential rain/wind or a thunderstorm). Clothing should be dark coloured.

Children should have some old, outdoor shoes or wellies they can wear in the outdoor area. They should have a second, clean pair of shoes to wear inside school. It would be helpful for children to have a change of clothes in case they get wet or muddy during their session. **If children are not dressed appropriately, they will not be allowed to take part in the session for safety reasons.** As always, please ensure items of clothing are named.

Please see below for each year group's session:

Early Years and Key Stage 1 - starting from next week (week beginning 7th September)

Reception- Friday morning every week

Year 1 – Wednesday afternoon every week

Year 2 – Friday afternoon every week – Please note children have PE in the morning so will need to come in PE kit with a change of clothes and shoes for Outdoor Learning

Key Stage 2

Key Stage 2 will have a session every two weeks starting from **next week (week beginning 7th September)**

Year 3 – Thursday morning every other week

Year 4 – Wednesday morning every other week

Year 5 – Monday morning every other week
